Bespoke Challenges

- + Bespoke Challenges are challenges which are run specifically for YOU. You choose the destination and trip, agree dates with us, and promote the trip to your supporters
- + You recruit the group! We work together on trip administration to ensure we have all the information we need to plan and operate the trip smoothly and safely. Everyone on the trip itself will raise funds for YOU
- + Fundraising challenges run specifically for your charity allow you a great deal of flexibility in everything from choosing the trip to sending out your own style of information, when and how you like
- + We can run bespoke challenges for groups of 20 participants upwards. A larger group tends to be more cost-effective for you as we can usually reduce the per person tour cost on a sliding scale as your group grows

Payment

5 months before departure we ask you for a deposit. From now on we stay in regular contact regarding numbers of participants and their progress.

2-3 months before departure

Pre-Trip Information Session

These sessions are a great way for your participants to meet up with us and discuss the trip in full. With an in-depth slideshow we advise on all preparations and kit.

2 months before departure

Final Details

Final deadlines occur now, all names to be confirmed and all their documentation must be complete. Final invoice due for payment.

Their Ben Nevis Challenge Weekend gives participants the chance to climb the UK's highest mountain, while their 1-day Avebury to Stonehenge Memory Walk is a mass participation event on very different terrain, across Salisbury Plain. The range of UK challenge events will soon be expanded further.

Europe

With classic cities, historic monuments and challenging environments from the Arctic Circle to the Alps, Europe offers a broad range of inspiring destinations for trekking and cycling challenges.

Why Offer a Challenge in Europe?

- + **Flight-free:** Some trips involve no flights; making them more environmentally-friendly and more economical
- + **Short-Haul Destinations:** often means lower tour cost and therefore lower fundraising target
- + **Trip Duration:** often under a week; appeals to supporters who can't commit to longer challenges
- + **Comfort Zone:** some people are not confident travelling somewhere with a very different culture, or want to avoid long-haul flights
- + **Aid to Fundraising:** can be easier to get sponsorship when friends and family have a notion of the challenge and can imagine the distance involved – ie cycling from London to Paris

Men 60% / Women 40% Average age: **Men 39 / Women 34**

A standard trekking group in Iceland would consist of:
Men 55% / Women 45% Average age: **Men 57 / Women 43**



Charity Case Study: Make it relevant!

The first challenge event run by Help for Heroes was the hugely successful Big Battlefield Bike Ride in 2008 – a cycling challenge through Northern France includes in the itinerary many historic sites connected with both World Wars into the itinerary. The event fitted perfectly with the new charity's supporter base: in its first year, almost 300 cyclists took part. The charity has built on that success with other themed cycle challenges in Europe as well as a range of other UK and long-haul challenges.

Sales Tip: Make it personal

We can alter an itinerary to start from or finish at your hospice, project or charity HQ. This can be especially effective for cycle challenges (e.g. cycle from Cornwall to Paris) but can work well for treks too.

Supporters of the charity trekked for 10 days in the Cederberg wilderness area of South Africa before earning the chance to see the World Cup Opening Ceremony. They are continuing this sporting theme with an upcoming trek in New Zealand to coincide with the Rugby World Cup.

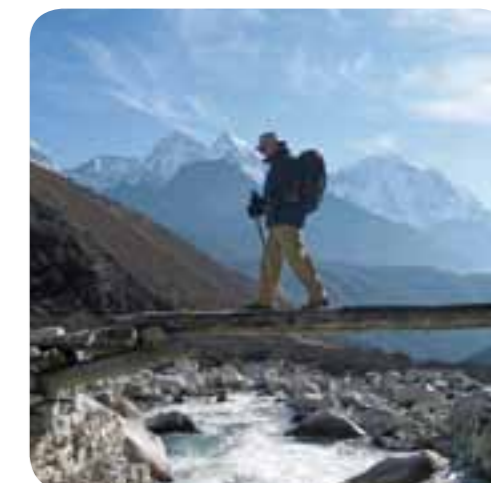

Macmillan offers a series of challenges in the Americas, both cycles and treks, some tough, some moderately graded - all have a clear challenge concept or 'hook'. Their Mexico Coast to Coast Cycle starts on the Gulf Coast and finishes on the Pacific Coast, a lesser known challenge concept but a real challenge for cyclists. Their Trek to Machu Picchu follows the Inca Trail, a well-known challenge that is still immensely popular, ending at the iconic Machu Picchu.

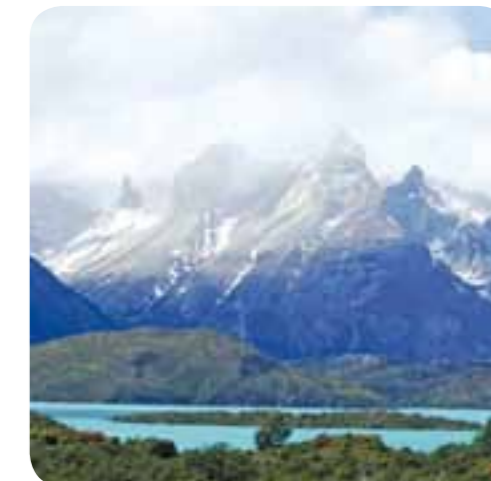
